

The Joy of Discovery

The day after we returned to Loja, a good friend of ours asked us if we could start a Bible study. She had family members who were interested in studying the Bible, including some who do not know the Lord. So, our second week back in Loja, Ecuador, we started a weekly study on the Life of Christ.

After a few weeks, our friend, Sandra, told us her adolescent niece and nephew were so anxious to get to the study that they were ready to leave an hour early. They had attended Bible studies and other activities at church, so she asked them, "Why are you so much more excited about this study?" Their answer was, "This study is different." Then they went on to mention some characteristics that attracted them to the meeting.

One of their comments that encouraged us greatly was, "Brother Jeff and Sister Theresa listen to what we have to say without correcting every little mistake we make." As we endeavor to help people have a clear understanding of God's word, it is tempting to correct every idea that we don't agree with. Even if a comment is clearly unbiblical, we have discovered that it is much more effective to look at the Bible passage and

lead people through the process of observation, to discover the truth they had previously missed. Please pray for us as we continue to develop this important skill.

Another characteristic that attracted them to the study is that we encouraged them to use a Bible application with audio. The nephew has a smart phone, and they love being able to use it to read and listen to the Bible.

In this study, we are reading through all four gospels in ten weeks. This means reading at least one chapter a day, some weeks a little more. It excites us to hear their observations about what they have read each week and to see their enthusiasm about reading the word of God.

A couple of weeks ago, God used this contagious enthusiasm to impact the life of one of our neighbors. T.M., who runs a small business near our house, accepted Jeff's invitation to attend the Bible study. He admitted he had rarely read the Bible, so it excited us that he was able to see that other people in the group were enthusiastic about reading God's word. Please pray that T.M. will continue to attend the study and discover the joy of discovering the truths of the Bible and applying them to his life.

Jesus told his disciples, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." (John 8:31-32, ESV). Please pray for wisdom from above to facilitate the joy of discovering God's truth, which leads to salvation and freedom in Christ.
